MAY SCHEDULE:



CAL.....Crochet Along.....Every Tuesday 1-4

We will be making the Brick Work Summer Sun Hat. This uses 1 ¼ skeins of dishcloth cotton yarn, and size I hook. Come once to get started, or come every week to sit & crochet.



KAL.....Knit Along.....Every Wednesday, 1-4

We will be making the Pima Silk Lace Top-Down T-Shirt. This uses 4-6 skeins DK weight yarn, sizes 7 & 6 circ in in 16 & 32". Come once to get started, or come every week to sit & knit.



Every Fri. this month.....1-4.....Sock Knitters Unite!

What a fun group to be a part of! Everyone is trying new things and succeeding!



Sat, May 4.....Flower Dishcloth.....1-4

This take half a skein of dishcloth cotton yarn (you can get 2 from 1 skein!), and size 7 needles. A fun & different pattern to knit. ***Pattern available all month long.***



Sat, May 18.....Estonian Twist Scarf.....1-4

A different stitch that is just stunning in this yarn. You need 1 skein KidSeta Yarn and size 8 needles, plus a single double point in size 6 or 7. ***Pattern available all month long.***



Sat, May 25.....Knitted Pansies.....1-4

A fun Spring project. You need small amounts of DK yarn with size 4 needles & some floral wire. The colors are up to you: 1 main color, black, yellow & green. ***Pattern available all month long.***



Thurs, May 30.....Spinning Group.....11-3

Welcoming all spinners -past, present & future. Come see a demonstration of this lost art.

Saturday, June 1.....Knitting Fixes Class.....taught by Jane Lasarenko.....\$20

Jane will teach you how to fix very common knitting mistakes, including some in cables. There will be a homework swatch to knit ahead of time, so call the shop to get that emailed to you. (Or stop in for a hard copy.) Space is limited, so sign up soon!

Learn to cast on, knit, purl, bind off and how to hide your ends. Materials needed: worsted weight yarn, size 7 needles, scissors and a darning needle.

Crochet 101.....By Appointment.....\$20

Learn to chain, single crochet, double crochet and how to hide your ends. Materials needed: worsted weight yarn, size H hook, scissors and a darning needle.
